

## **3 DAY WEBINAR SERIES:**

Commemorating the 1st Anniversary of Hurricane Dorian's Landfall

#### Introduction:

On the eve of the first anniversary of Hurricane Dorian's landfall, Bahamas Strong Alliance is hosting a three-part webinar series designed to highlight the leverage that can be gained through formalized private sector involvement in disaster preparedness and response. Each webinar session will focus on key priorities, including lessons learned from Dorian, the hazards and potential impact of a major hurricane hitting New Providence, and our medical capacity to respond to natural disasters. Hurricane Dorian, the strongest recorded hurricane to make landfall in The Bahamas, devastated Abaco and Grand Bahama in September, 2019. The historic hurricane also created one of the most diverse and impactful private sector responses to a natural disaster the country has ever seen.
